STUDENTS AND STAFF TOGETHER CAN STOP BULLYING AT EOJHS!

It is not welcome in our school and we will put a stop to it!

Stop A Bully is a national non-profit organization and Canada-wide anti-bullying program developed by a B.C. teacher which allows any student who is a victim or witness of severe bullying to be able to **safely** report the details to school officials without risk of becoming a target themselves. The Stop A Bully program helps increase **bullying awareness & accountability** within schools to allow officials to be more proactive in preventing serious incidents of bullying, abuse or suicidal ideation.

Stop a Bully is a safe and anonymous way that students can report what is going on in their life or in their school. Students can choose to leave their name or not. But it is the first step to helping make our school a safer place for everyone.

No student can be helped (witness, target or perpetrator) until the school has the information. **Student Safety must be the TOP PRIORITY.** If you are worried about a friend, you can also submit a report. You are the ones that know best what is going on in a friend's life. Help us help them.

Stop A Bully program details:

- Provides schools/students with a **safe & anonymous** Bullying Reporting System
- Increases bullying **awareness & accountability** within the school
- Allows schools to be **proactive** in addressing bullying before more serious incidents occur
- **Empowers all students** to become active participants in reducing bullying in their school showing that we will not put up our friends and classmates being treated bad.

Some things to be aware of:



- All reports will be forwarded to Administration for support.
- Any reports can be submitted anonymously or with names attached but for safety reasons IP addresses can be traced as to where the student was when the report was made.

What can I do as a parent?

- Make sure your child knows that this link on our school website is there! Students should feel empowered to take this reporting into their own hands, so that they feel that they are 'doing something' to stop what is happening. Whenever possible encourage your child to do the report themselves and to leave their name so that supports can be in place for the student who was brave enough to make this report. Please look at the school website and familiarize yourself with the links on the web page. (the "HAND" and the "Submit A Report" are directly linked to the report).

Read carefully before submitting a BULLY REPORT:

- *Stop A Bully* always recommends to students that they talk to their parent/guardian, or a school staff member, regarding any incident of harassment or violence at school.
- For severe cases of violence or threat of harm we recommend that students, or their parents, contact the [RCMP](#) or local police immediately for assistance.
- *Stop A Bully* is for 'non-emergency' reporting as it is not monitored 24 hours per day
- if a student needs immediate assistance or counseling they need to contact the [Kids Help Phone](#) 1 800 668 6868
- All information that is submitted on the Bully Report form will be **forwarded to the Principal and Counselor of the school.**
- Any **photos or video that are included** as evidence will also be forwarded to the Principal and Counselor of the school.
- **Complete and specific details** of any incident are always needed in order for action to be taken by school staff.
- Although your name may not be included on the form it is possible from the incident details that the school staff may determine who submitted the form.

It is possible that they may approach you directly to offer assistance and/or collect more information.

- *Stop A Bully* has no control over the actions (or lack of action) of a school in dealing with BULLY REPORTS, but we encourage every school to use the reported details in taking all steps necessary to stop the harassment. In submitting a Bully Report all users agree to the Terms of Use.
- If a **Principal is unreachable or declines to read** BULLY REPORTS we will not be able to provide any assistance with that particular school.
- It is **unlawful to make accusations that are untrue**, with any such submissions your IP address and/or school account may be passed along to authorities for investigation.
